INFORMATION:

The U/O's were dispatched to a report of a possible fight at the Yuma Bar.

VENUE:

WEXFORD COUNTY, SPRINGVILLE TWP

AREA CHECK:

The U/O's were advised by Wexford County Dispatch that a third party caller had heard what sounded like a female yelling and screaming over by the Yuma Bar.

The U/O's arrived in the area and were flagged down by the caller. He stated that the yelling had stopped but that he had seen a vehicle drive away from the bar. The U/O's continued on in an attempt to find the vehicle.

The U/O's pulled the patrol vehicle onto 2nd St. and observed a female lying on the front porch of a residence at 112 2nd St. A male was also observed standing over her with his hands on his knees. The U/O's stopped the patrol vehicle and contacted the two.

As the U/O's were approaching the two, the female crawled into the residence. It was observed that she had a significant amount of blood on her head and she seemed to be in great pain. Tpr. Rickles followed the female into the residence while Tpr. Koboldt made contact with the male.

Tpr. Koboldt asked the male for I.D., which he supplied. The license identified him as JOEL NATHAN DUFRESNE w/m [REDACTED]

INTERVIEW SUSPECT:

DUFRESNE was interviewed in front of the residence.

Tpr. Koboldt asks DUFRESNE what happened to the female. DUFRESNE states that he doesn't know, he just got to the residence. It should be noted that the suspect is highly intoxicated at this point.

Tpr. Koboldt asks DUFRESNE how he got some blood on his shirt and how did he come to have fresh cuts on his hands if he didn't know anything about how the female got hurt. He stated that he had just gotten back from Petoskey where he had gotten into a bar fight. That was how he got hurt. He had just arrived back at the house and found the girl lying on the porch. The U/O's checked the with the MSP 78 troops about any bar fights in the area that night. They advised that they were not familiar with any fights and neither was dispatch.

Once Tpr. Koboldt started to press DUFRESNE about what had happened, DUFRESNE became irritable and defensive. It was at this point the DUFRESNE started to preach about his racist views and how the police are just hired guns for the government and are willing to go out and just kill people just for the sake of killing them. Tpr. Koboldt was not able to get any more information out of DUFRESNE about the female. He seemed to be building up a head of steam and enjoying explaining his racist views to someone else not familiar with him.

VICTIM INFORMATION:

Tpr. Ricklefs was in an upstairs room with the victim, W [REDACTED]. She was in and out of consciousness and was bleeding from her head. At that point, Tpr. Ricklefs felt that E.M.S. should be dispatched to the scene.

E.M.S. RESPONSE:

E.M.S. responded to the residence on 2nd St. DUFRESNE was at first reluctant to let the paramedics in to look at his girlfriend. The U/O's explained to him at that point that it wasn't up to him and that the paramedics were going to examine W [REDACTED].

While W [REDACTED] was being attended to, DUFRESNE kept leaning forward and whispering in her ear. Tpr. Ricklefs kept telling DUFRESNE to get back and leave her alone. He would comply and then attempt it again. It was unknown what he was telling her.

INTERVIEW VICTIM:

Once W[REDACTED] arrived at the hospital, she was more alert but still in some pain. The U/O's had R.N. Shemarie Regonard ask W[REDACTED] what had happened that night. She stated that she had been at a party at FOSTER'S house when she decided to walk over to the Yuuna Bar to see if DUFRESNE was there. She stated that she didn't see him there and decided to walk back to the party. As she was crossing a back yard, she heard a mans voice tell her that he was going to beat her ass and then she got hit. She doesn't remember anything else after that. She awoke on the porch of the residence with DUFRESNE.

The U/O's then walked into the examination room and asked W[REDACTED] if she even saw the man that hit her. She said it was to dark to see him. She couldn't tell us anything about him.

The U/O's asked W[REDACTED] if she had gotten into any arguments with anyone that night or if she knew anyone in the area that might try and hurt her. She stated that she didn't have any trouble with anyone that night.

The U/O's told W[REDACTED] that they believed that DUFRESNE is the one that had hurt her. At that point she began to cry but insisted that he hadn't. The U/O's explained to her that he had injuries on his hands and fresh blood on his T-shirt that proved that he had been in a fight right before the U/O's talked with him. W[REDACTED] began to cry again and but all she would say is that DUFRESNE didn't do it. The U/O's talked with her for several more minutes but she kept stating that DUFRESNE didn't do it and that she didn't know who had hit her. Just some mysterious man.

INJURIES:

W[REDACTED] had a cut on her head that did require stitches. She also had some scrapes on her upper body where it looked like someone had dragged her across the ground. She had cuts on her hands. The doctor also felt that she may have some broken ribs but he needed to wait for X-Ray to come back.
